報名須知

1. 請填寫網上報名表格，以預約欲到訪參觀的日期及時段。所有報名須在活動日起計至少一個月前遞交預約申請。
2. 本館將於收到申請後一個月內聯絡負責參觀活動的老師，以確認所選的到訪日期及時段。
3. 成功獲安排參觀的申請者將收到確認電郵，並隨函附上活動詳情、參觀須知、參觀前參考資料及教師資源，以及「付款通知書」（如適用）。學校團體須在「付款通知書」發出後的10個工作天之內及到訪日期前完成付款（以先到者為準）。
4. 活動一經確認，恕不接受改期或門票退款。

2: Special exhibitions are **“Ancient Egypt Unveiled: Treasures from Egyptian Museums” (Gallery 9), from 20 November 2025 to 31 August 2026, and **“Treasures of Global Jewellery from the Metropolitan Museum of Art: The Body Transformed”** (Gallery 8), from 15 April 2026 to 19 October 2026. Primary and secondary schools successfully granted free general admission tickets can reserve add-on tickets for the special exhibition **“Ancient Egypt Unveiled: Treasures from Egyptian Museums”** at a cost of HK\$60 per student and HK\$120 per accompanying teachers. Please specify your preferred special exhibition(s) on your application. The Museum will make arrangements based on the application details and operational capacity. Any special requests regarding the visit should be specified in the remarks field of the application form.

Recommended Teacher-to-student ratio

Please ensure there are sufficient teachers to accompany your students at the Museum. The recommended teacher-to-student ratio for primary and secondary school visits is 1:15, for kindergarten visits is 1:5, and for special school visit is 1:3.

Application Guidelines

1. Submit the online application to book your preferred date and time. Applications need to be made at least 1 month prior to the visit.
2. HKPM will contact applicants / teachers within 1 month to confirm the date and time of the visit.
3. Successful applicants will receive a confirmation email with details of the visit, visit guidelines, reference material, learning resources, and (if applicable) payment notice. The school should complete the payment within 10 working days after the issuance of the payment notice and prior to the date of visit, whichever comes first.
4. Once the application is confirmed, the Museum shall not be liable to assist in the rescheduling of the event date or make any refund to processed tickets of accompanying teachers.
